75km Challenge Ride

A smooth, wide, fast and mostly flat course. Riders will depart from the start line on the Ringwood Bypass, and descend down onto EastLink's south bound carriageway with a sweeping left-hand curve. The southern leg on EastLink flies over major roads, zips between wetlands, and cuts under the Monash Fwy before shooting through the slot between Princes Hwy (below) and Heatherton Rd (above). Escaping residential areas, the southern section towards Frankston passes commercial developments and heads into open country. A large roundabout just off EastLink at Rutherford Road is the turn around point, from which riders will make the north bound journey back to Ringwood on the opposite carriageway. In the closing stages, two challenging dips (1:20 gradient down and then up) through each of the 1.6km Melba and Mullum Mullum tunnels will separate the best from the rest! Look out for the four major art works along the route.
