

Fundraising Page FAQ's

Every Entrant in the Hanover ConnectEast Ride for Home event will be allocated their own personal fundraising page. It is through this page that your friends and family can show their support for Hanover, and for your participation in the event, by making a donation to help break the cycle of homelessness.

Your supporters can find your page by :

Visiting rideforhome.com.au, clicking on 'Sponsor a rider' and entering your name

Going straight to your fundraising page link – see further information below.

Logging in

To set up your fundraising page, you login to your account :

To Login Click the Rider login button which is located on the top right hand corner of the Home page.

A login pop-up will appear on the screen.

TIP: If the pop up fails to appear, you may need to adjust your computer's firewall and pop up settings.

Enter your email and password into the Login pop-up. These details were sent to you in your email entry receipt.

TIP: make sure your email is entered correctly with no spaces left at the end of the address.

If you can't remember your password please click the "**forgotten your password?**" link. Fill in the details and this will send your password to your email address. Otherwise call the team at Right Angle Events on **9416 4609** and they can retrieve it for you.

Once details are entered click **Login**. This will take you to your Fundraising page.

Editing your Fundraising Page

To edit your page click the **Edit your Page** link on Right hand side of the screen. This allows you to set you fundraising target, write a personal message and set your profile picture.

Upload your Profile Picture

Click on the **Edit your Page** link. Click on the link next to the profile image icon. This will take you to the upload page. You must download the **Aurigma Image Uploader** to complete this.

Once the image uploader has loaded, browse your files and select your picture. Click **Upload** to complete. If you encounter further problems contact the team at Right Angle events on **9416 4609**.



Invite your Friends to sponsor you.

To share your page with friends and invite them to sponsor you click on the **Email your Friends** link on the right hand side of the screen. Enter your personal message and your friend's emails and hit **Send**. This will send an email with information on the ride, your personal fundraising target, your current funds raised as well as a link to your fundraising page.

NB: This will be a personal message only to the email recipient. Your friend's personal email addresses will not be viewed by each other.

Alternatively you can copy and paste the URL of your fundraising page from your welcome email into an email or Facebook page to send. This url looks like this :

People can also find your page by searching your name through the **Sponsor a Rider** link on the website home page www.rideforhome.com.au. If you don't have a copy of your fundraising web address, you can find it by searching for yourself in this function.

What happens once a donation is made?

All donations made to a rider are automatically displayed on the rider's fundraising page, along with any personal messages of support.

A receipt for the donation will be sent to the donor's specified email address, when the donation is made.

How will the Transaction appear on my bank statement?

The Hanover ConnectEast Ride for Home is being professionally managed by Right Angle Events on behalf of Hanover Welfare Services and ConnectEast. All transactions will appear on bank statements as **Right Angle Events**. 100% of all donations are passed on to Hanover Welfare Services.

Creating Fundraising Teams and Networks.

The fundraising webpage provides links for riders to set up or join a fundraising network – which is a group of entrants linked to fundraise together.
